## **OPEN CHAMPIONS 65 YEARS APART**





Sixty National Open Charapionships ago Horace Rawlins was the winner. That was the first USGA Open, and Rawlins, then 19, remains the youngest Champion of all time. He received a gold medal and \$150 for his 91-82—173 score at Newport (R.I.) Golf Club. Ten professionals and one amateur entered. This month at Cherry Hills in Denver, Bill Casper, Jr., will defend honors he won a year ago at Winged Foot, Mamaroneck, N. Y. Casper's score was 71-68-69-74—282. There were 2,385 entries and Casper's prize money was \$12,000—eighty times Horace Rawlin's prize.
