## **DO YOU KNOW YOUR GOLF?**

Here is a golf competition in which there's no waiting on the first tee, you play as you sit, use a pencil instead of clubs, and a round can be played indoors at night.

But you need to know something about the Rules of Golf, etiquette, definitions, history and records of the game.

1. Which six of the following players won both the Amateur and the Open Championships?:

5. What made 1932 a notable year for Gene Sarazen.

6. If an out-of-bounds stake interferes with the player's swing, may he remove the stake? What Rule is involved?

7. A player drives 250 yards up the middle of the fairway, but before he can reach the ball to play his second shot:

- (a) A dog picks up the ball in his mouth, runs 50 yards with it, and drops it into a bunker;
- (b) A dog runs off with the ball and it is never found.

What is the procedure in each case and what Rule governs?

8. Who was the first native American to win the Open Championship, and in what year did he win?

9. In match play, a player's ball knocks his opponent's ball into the cup. Does the opponent have to replace the ball or may he consider it holed? What Rule governs? 10. What is meant by "rub of the green?"

11. Is a chipping club legal which has two faces that can be used for both lefthanded and right-handed strokes? What Rule governs?

12. Who was the first native American to win the British Open Championship, and in what year did he win?

13. A player faces a shot over a hill to a hidden green. He asks his opponent, "What club do I need to get home?" The opponent answers, "A 6-iron." Is the player penalized for asking advice? Is the opponent penalized for giving advice? What Rule governs?

14. For whom is the trophy named which goes to the winning national team in the World Amateur Team Championship? Which country now holds the trophy?

15. Is it permissible to brush casual water from the line of putt? What Rule governs?

16. Is the use of automotive carts prohibited by the Rules of Golf? What Rule, if any, is involved?

17. Name the two players who most recently won the Amateur Championship twice in consecutive years?

18. What is the penalty in match play and in stroke play for playing out of turn?
