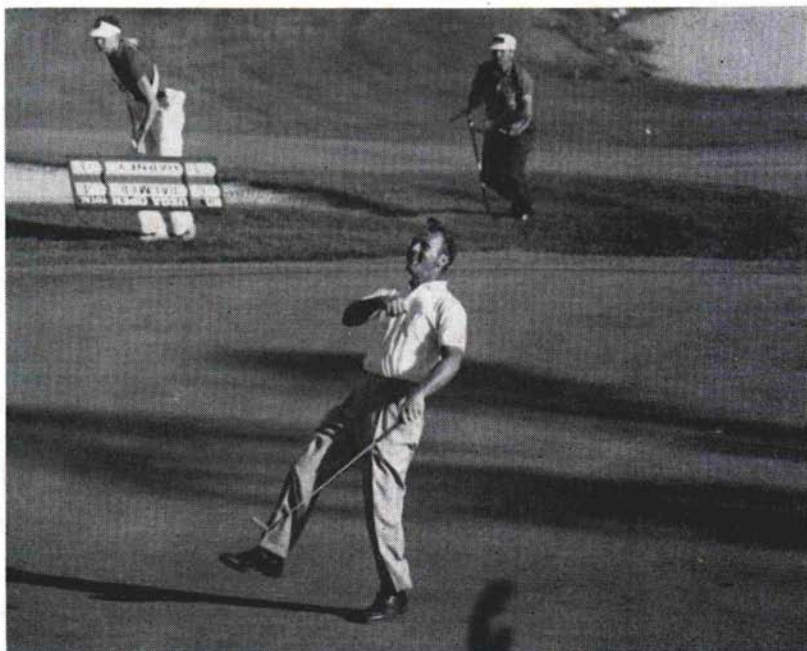

Arnold Palmer whips off his cap and tosses it into the air after completing his final round in 65 strokes in the 60th Open Championship at Cherry Hills Country Club, Denver. A few minutes afterwards he learned he was the new Open Champion. Palmer scored 72-71-72-65—280 and his last stroke was a five-foot putt. Jack Nicklaus finished second with 71-71-69-71—282, highest placing by an amateur since 1933 when John Goodman won the Championship.
