Last spring the Portage Lake Golf Club, Houghton, Mich., deemed it essential to have more rain covers upon the course, and being limited in funds the Green Committee designed a very cheap rain cover which has proved to be very satisfactory. Thinking that possibly some other clubs would be interested in this feature, I am submitting herewith plans and specifications of the shelters we constructed. These shelters can be turned around the post to any point of the compass against the wind, thereby affording protection from a summer squall. They furnish ample protection for a foursome with the caddies. The golf clubs are placed back of the seat.
